Airport capacity / Submission of Entries

The current capacity limit of the airport has been set at 80 gliders. We expect this capacity should be fully sufficient to host the WWGC. As we would like to have at least rough idea for organisation purposes, we would like to ask all countries to report the estimated number of pilots in each class as soon as possible to the official email address by January 31st, 2025, at the latest. These numbers are non-binding and will be used for estimation only.

Following this, official entries need to be submitted individually by each pilot and team captain on the competition website before **March 31**st, **2025** (The website registration will be launched before the end of year 2024). Alongside individual entries, each NAC needs to fill in and submit a NAC Nomination Form to confirm the nomination of their pilots. This form needs to be sent via email to the official email address before March 31st, 2025.

Accommodation

There is also a lot of possibilities of accommodation in historical town Kutna Hora which is app. 15 km from Zbraslavice (15 minutes by car).

Common websites such as Booking.com and Airbnb are widely used for accommodation booking in the Czech Republic. If you need any assistance, please contact us.

There will be a temporary campsite on the airfield, close to the glider parking area, with the usual facilities e.g., showers, toilets, and electrical hook-ups nearby.

The accommodation fees at the airfield will be 15€ per tent / caravan per night and 7€ per person per night. Payment will be collected at the end of the Championships and can be paid by card or cash.

Championship Classes

The 13th FAI Women's World Gliding Championships will be held in the following classes (as defined in Sporting Code, Section 3, chapter 5):

- Club Class
- Standard Class
- 18 Metre Class

Additional safety rules

All competing gliders must be fitted with a serviceable industry-standard anti-collision system and red or white strobe lights that comply with SC3 Annex A 4.1.1d.

Contest Area

The contest area includes the territories of the Czech Republic, Austria, Germany and Poland. The Contest Area Altitude limit is FL95. More details will be published in Self-briefing and daily briefings. Please ensure your third-party insurance covers territories of all mentioned countries.

Entry fee and launch fee

Entry Fee: EUR 890, payable in Euros.

The payment of Entry Fee is due by March 31st, 2025.

The entry fee is adjusted to 890 EUR to account for the increase in FAI sanction fees of 38 CHF from when the bid was submitted.

Aero-tow to 600 metres AAL:

Pre-payment of 10 launches will be required during registration. This payment can preferably be made together with entry fee payment, by transfer before registration or by card during registration.

Number of allowable entries per NAC

Each NAC may enter not more than 3 pilots in each class (excluding women's reigning champions). A reserve pilot can replace a nominated pilot in the event of withdrawal, provided that the entry fees for the officially entered pilots have been received.

A competitor must satisfy all requirements listed in the Sporting Code, Annex A, Section 3.2.

Insurance

Third-Party Insurance

Third-party insurance meeting the requirements of EC Regulation 785/2004 is required for each participating sailplane.

The minimum third-party liability insurance for single-seat gliders with certified MTOM < 500kg is 750,000 Special Drawing Rights (SDR), and for MTOM < 1000kg is SDR 1,500,000.

Documentary proof of insurance must be provided in the English language.

Please ensure your third-party insurance covers territories of all countries specified in Contest Area section.

Personal Medical Insurance

Personal medical insurance (covering accidents and sickness, including any hospital costs and transportation back to the team member's country of residence) is required for all team members. Documentary proof of insurance must be provided in the English language and provided by pilots during registration for themselves and by the team captain during registration for all other team members.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Mandatory additional equipment

Red or White strobe lights must be operational in all gliders and comply fully with SC3 Annex A 4.1.1.d.

Audio variometer must be fitted and used in all sailplanes.

All instruments, PDA, GPS navigators etc. must be firmly mounted in the glider in such a way that the pilot's vision is not affected.

High visibility markings are not required.

FR calibration certificates are not mandatory. In case the competitor has no proper FR calibration to be considered by the scorer in case of claim, the altitude record from IGC file is binding.

Radio Communications

Due to radio frequency congestion in European airspace, the organiser together with authorities will allocate radio frequencies with 8.33kHz spacing for team use during the championships.

All glider radios and ground station radios must be approved 8.33kHz compliant radios.

Use of radio frequencies other than official gliding frequencies and published team frequencies for team communications will be strictly prohibited.

List of frequencies and their allocation to the teams will be present before the competition.

Emergency Frequency: 121.500kHz (monitored by ATCC Control Centre)

Requirements for flags, anthem discs or tapes

Flags and anthems will be provided by the organiser. Flag design and anthem recording will be taken from Wikipedia. Team captains must check that their national flag and anthem are correct on Wikipedia or inform the Organiser of any errors before March 31st, 2025.
